DESCRIPTION

LOW TEMP BLEACH is a sodium percarbonate based bleach used for stain removal and general whitening of silks, rayons and colours.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

As a **bleach agent** use at a rate of 6-8g per 1 kg of dry weight of items, either at a room temperature or up to 65° C. As a **soak liquid** for stain removal use at a rate of 10-20g per 1L of hot water.
