#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

SODIUM CHLORITE 31% is used in conjunction with HYDROCHLORIC ACID. The use rates depend upon a number of factors, but in general 1:1 ratio of SODIUM CHLORITE 31% and HYDROCHLORIC ACID is recommended.

#### SAFETY INFORMATION

SODIUM CHLORITE 31% is classified as Hazardous according to the GHS. SODIUM CHLORITE 31% is classified as Dangerous Goods according to the ADG Code ( $7^{th}$  Ed). SODIUM CHLORITE 31% is a Scheduled Poison according to the SUSMP. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Refer to SDS for further information.

#### FIRST AID INFORMATION
